

ORDINANCE NO. 1617

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6.2 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, AND SECTION 675 OF THE 1992 ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, VACATING A STREET, ALLEY, OR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, OR ANY PART THEREOF, HEREIN DESCRIBED, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS RECORDING.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the City Council a petition to vacate the premises hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 13, 2021, on the said petition and after public notice was given, pursuant to Section 6.2 of the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the proposed vacation does not destroy or interfere with the rights of any person, corporation, or municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that the premises hereinafter described are no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the following described portion of the public alley ways:

The north south alley in that part of Sub-Lots 1,2,3 and 4, SUBDIVISION OF LOTS 1, 2, 17 AND 18, BLOCK 10, SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 107, RANGE 20, Steele County, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat thereof, on file in the Recorder's Office, Said Steele County, of Lot 2, Block 10, TOWN OF OWATONNA, according to the recorded plat thereof on file in said Recorder's Office.

TOGETHER WITH That part of the east west alley in said SUBDIVISION OF LOTS 1, 2, 17 AND 18, BLOCK 10, SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 107, RANGE 20 lying westerly of the following described line: Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 18 said Block 10, TOWN OF OWATONNA; thence South 00degrees 14 minutes 33 seconds West, bearing based on Steele County coordinate database NAD83, 16.50 feet to the northeast corner of said Sub-Lot 4 of Lot 1.

TOGETHER WITH The West 12.00 feet of Lot 16, said Block 10, TOWN OF OWATONNA. may be and hereby is vacated.


SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be filed for record in the offices of the City Clerk and the City Engineer of the City of Owatonna and its title added to Appendix IV of the 1992 Ordinance Code of the City of Owatonna.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall cause an original copy hereof to be filed for record and duly recorded in the office of the Steele County Recorder in and for Steele County, Minnesota.
